TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING GENERAL DEVELOPMENT ORDER 1973

DIRECTION UNDER ARTICLE 4

WHEREAS the Council of the District of South Staffordshire as District Planning Authority are satisfied that it is expedient that the development as set out in the Schedule hereto should not be carried out at Halfpenny Green Airfield, Bobbington in the County of Stafford (as shown on the plan annexed hereto) unless permission is granted on an application in that behalf.

NOW THEREFORE the said Council in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1973 HEREBY DIRECT that the development permitted by Class IV of the First Schedule of the said Order at the above Airfield shall not commence for a period of six months from the date of this Direction.

REASONS FOR DIRECTION

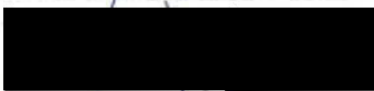
- (1) The Development is prejudicial to the proper planning of the area.
