The property is situated on the Landywood Enterprise Park, off Holly Lane in Great Wyrley. Landywood Enterprise Park is a well-established and popular industrial and commercial area near Wolverhampton.

The property benefits from excellent connections to the motorway transport system including the M54, M6, M6 Toll and M5. The Enterprise Centre is close to the A5 and A34.




