Coach House, Stourton

Permanent storage of a converted horse box and steps; the horse lorry in question is being converted into a camper van for myself and my partner to travel in once I retire. It runs and it's moveable so is not a permanent fixture.

Timber pergola; this is a seating area for on an afternoon when the sun is going down.

Raised planting beds; we have previously these to grow our own vegetables and will be in the future.

Small metal shed; used to keep gardening tools.

Fencing; this has been in place since 2016, it keeps the dogs in, otherwise there is a 15ft drop onto next doors land.
