I have previously contacted you by letter to share my apprehension with regard to the proposed development near to Essington village and Linthouse Lane Wednesfield.

As a resident of Wednesfield in the area being considered, I feel I must reiterate my concerns, especially as I have lately experienced some excessively crowded roads both on Linthouse Lane and also on Essington Rd.

The number of homes being considered with their inevitable number of extra vehicles, conjures up the image of an area constantly grid locked, resulting in even more air pollution. That will add to the problem of us losing both our green belt and farmland which are commonly referred to as our 'lungs'.
