In 2005, researchers at the University of Oxford found an association between the distance from power lines and childhood cancer in Britain. This is a view that is not Widely circulated due to the knock-on litigation of existing home owners located close to the power lines. Power lines cross the middle of Site 463 Billy Buns Lane and site 459.
