Thanks for getting back to me, and my apology for the confusion.

The main point in the document is around the business case for building the houses, I believe you to be legally compliant in this area, but as has been seen by the program being put on hold, that there is a deficiency in this area.

The part that I do not think is legally compliant is around making it easy for locals to respond. i.e. As a separate point as head of ICT for the fire service, the hard work that has been required to provide feedback will have made it impossible for a number of people to respond. The website is not WCAG compliant and the use of pdf forms are completely inappropriate tool to use to provide feedback. The Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) are the golden standard of web accessibility around the globe.
