Having read the Local Plan, I wish to comment on the inclusion of land just South East of Stafford, as I do not believe its inclusion is sound nor complies with the duty to cooperate.

Although the proposed inclusion of 81 units of housing near Weeping Cross is in South Staffs it would defact form part of the town of Stafford, to which it would join. This is therefore not a sound proposal for the following reasons:

- 1. The inhabitants of the proposed houses would rely on infrastructure within Stafford, without Stafford BC receiving any council tax funding.
- 2. The local GP service at Weeping Cross (which I use) is already overwhelmed and it is now difficult to get a GP appointment. This would be made worse if an additional 81 households sought to register.
- 3. The A34 Stafford Cannock Road, which the new inhabitants would use, is also overused with frequent traffic jams in the direction of Stafford. There has been grid lock at least twice this week to my knowledge, with traffic backing up to the edge of Stafford. This will only be made worse by additional housing along this route.
- 4. Any children living in the proposed development would be unable to attend the schools on the East side of Stafford, which are already all full (as confirmed to me recently by the councillor responsible). This would mean



further journeys into and across Stafford, adding to the existing congestion and reducing our air quality again.

- 5. I understand the Stafford Borough Council is opposed to the inclusion of the proposed housing near Weeping Cross and therefore its inclusion conflicts with the duty to cooperate.
- 6. I believe South Staffs Council can meet its housing target without the inclusion of the proposed units near Weeping Cross and therefore the development is unnecessary.


