I object to the use of greenbelt for housing in this locality, this is contrary to government policy and the provisions of the Levelling Up and Regeneration bill to recycle brownfield land. There is ample brownfield land within 5 miles in the urban area of Wolverhampton which would benefit from regeneration. I understand this is outside South Staffordshire's boundaries but it seems hugely short sighted to sacrifice the environment due to a county boundary. If S.Staffs has no brownfield land, the duty to co-operate should extend to the GBBCHMA benefitting from having its brownfield land developed ahead of greenbelt destruction.
