As any serious consideration been given to the "Copart" site as a viable alternative to the Billy Buns site?

Development on the Billy Buns / Gilbert Lane site destroy the village both aesthetically and spiritually. What measures are in place to ensure this does not happen when the development goes ahead?

The industrial areas of Wombourne are in total need of redevelopment. Redeveloping those areas could avoid infringement of green belt for retail, housing and business needs. What consideration has been given to this?

Wombourne is already congested. How will vehicles be managed?

In general I am totally opposed to all the recommendation made in the report. If Wombourne is to expand it should be done on the west side of the village. Not the north/east side. The fear I have is Wombourne will become a congested extension of the Wolverhampton sprawl and be consumed in the process, destroying it's unique character.
