I am supportive of development and change, but it has to take nature alongside it and adapt to a changing climate, and not against it. There is no evidence that further development can be sustainable and protect the natural environment. Relying on existing green infrastructure (already under public pressure and in decline) is not delivering policies on protecting the natural environment and adapting to climate change.

The NPPF already had a requirement to protect biodiversity, recent developments have resulted in biodiversity loss, degraded water courses/water quality and failed to protect important green infrastructure (hedges/mature trees). Biodiversity and green infrastructure degradation has occurred on the periphery of the site (loss of ancient hedges/trees), and biodiversity loss and pressures on biologically important sites damaged by increasing public pressure (Highgate SSSI, Kinver SSSI, Himley Plantation). The plan has to include allocation for new open spaces to mitigate increasing numbers of residents, and protect existing sites allocated for nature conservation in order to be able to protect biodiversity, biodiversity net gain is not evidenced within previous site allocation development. To protect and deliver net gain on biodiversity, space has to be allocated alongside housing and employment. Development should include developing the natural environment as well as housing and built infrastructure. Ambition should be to deliver sustainable houses, and not leave it to the new residents to have retrospectively fund solar panels, heat source pumps and electric car chargers, as standard. Existing green space requires funding to be able to absorb increasing public pressures, and areas set aside for biodiversity.
