South Staffordshire District Council (SSDC) have declared a 'CLIMATE CRISIS' This plan is a Plan NOT fit for purpose to tackle the Climate Crisis that (SSDC) itself has Declared and has absolutely NO chance of reducing Carbon Emissions In fact the Plan will only increase Carbon Emissions which won't meet the International agreements made by the Government to reduce Carbon Emissions and reach Net Zero targets and lower Global temperature rise.

Other Countries such as Germany and Sweden have already taken Governments to High Courts on the grounds of inadequate Climate Change action in violation of the ECHR Human Rights Laws. This Plan could open up such legal action as inadequate and not fit for purpose to prevent Climate Change or Global warming targets agreed by the British Government.
