I would like to comment on this. My comment is very simple and is the following:

The Green Belt must be preserved without question. Under no circumstances should a developer be given approval to build on Green Belt land.

If - and ONLY IF - strong independent and verified evidence proves that a sufficiently large number of additional homes are needed in this area, then a process to build a new NewTown (similar to Telford) should be considered. This is the only acceptable solution if there are not enough brownfield sites left in the area to build on.
