MY REASONS FOR OBJECTIONS:-

THE USE OF SITE 036C FAILS THE "NATIONAL PLANNING POLICY FRAMEWORK" 19/12/2023. SECTION 15 'CONSERVING & ENHANCING THE NATURAL ENVIRONMENT' COMPLIANCE WITH 'NPPF' IS A ~~LEGAL~~ LEGAL OBLIGATION.

1) THE GATEWAY TO STAFFORD IS ENHANCED BY THE BEAUTY OF THE FARMLAND ON SITE 036C. THE FARM HAS BEEN FARMED WITH LOCAL PRODUCE BY THREE GENERATIONS OF THE SAME (PARROTT FAMILY). PRODUCING BEEF CATTLE AND POTATOES A LOCAL SOURCE OF FOOD PRODUCTS WITH NO AIRMILES. SURELY THIS IS A STAPLE FOOD WE AS A POPULATION CANNOT AFFORD TO LOOSE??

2) THE LAND IS ALSO HOME TO THE BEAUTIFUL RED DEER, [REDACTED] BATS, BIRDS OF MANY SPECIES, ONCE THIS LAND IS BUILT ON THESE ANIMALS WILL LOOSE THEIR HABITAT AND OUR FUTURE GENERATIONS WILL NOT BE ABLE TO ENJOY.

3) SCHOOLS IN THE AREA ARE FULL TO CAPACITY SO EXTRA PROVISION WOULD NEED TO BE MADE AVAILABLE TO TRANSPORT CHILDREN TO OTHER SCHOOLS, WHICH WILL CAUSE MORE AIR POLLUTION AND TRAFFIC JAMS INTO TOWN. ALREADY INTOLERABLE AT PEAK TIMES AND DURING N6 MOTORWAY CLOSURES.
