As a resident of Cherrybrook I feel this element of the local plan (Allocation 005, Cherrybrook) to be unsound. There are a number of concerns which require serious consideration. The M6 motorway is considerably busier since this land was moved from greenbelt to safe guarded land and has since been extented to a 4 lane motorway. Junctions 13-15 are one of the busiest sections of road with circa of 117,000 vehicles per day. The air & noise pollution caused by this already has a huge physical and mental health impact for current residents and is a huge concern. The district council must have a duty of care to their local residents.

The land is also bordered to the north by the canal and riverside heritage where a variety of wildlife inhabit, including bats. Developing on this site will have a huge impact on their habitat. The access to Cherrybrook currently sees in circa of 500 vehicles passing through, adding an additional 200 cars for 81 houses is dangerous and unsound. The suggested entrance/exit to the proposed development is also of concern and is questionable as to whether it is a safe option. (Continue on a separate sheet /expand box if necessary)

In 1996 the planning inspector stated that the site be considered for 63 houses, but then added that should the M6 be widened then the number of dwellings should be reduced to ensure a safe distance barrier between the houses and the M6. Meaning with the M6 being widened by 25% a 25% reduction of dwellings should be implemented to coinside.
