Following our meeting with the planning team on 7th December, I am emailing to share the specific details we require for the drop-off area being included as part of the development of the land next to my school. Below are the specific points:-

- We need it to be a long lay-by, not a conventional car park shaped as a square/rectangle area with parking bays it needs to be a one-way road from the existing road next to school
- We need a gate at the start and end/exit of the road to the lay-by so we can control access during the school day
- As the new one-way road arrives at the side of the school site, behind the existing house, we need lots of parking bays all in parallel along a lay-by (at least 40 parking bays)
- Parents will drive down the one-way road, arrive at the lay-by and temporarily pull into a
 parking bay while their child gets out of the car onto a pavement/path. Once out of the car,
 the parent then continues along the one-way round to exist the area back onto the main
 highway. We do not want a car park which parents park on and get out of their cars instead
 we want a 'drop-off' system
- A gate will need to be installed where the pavement arrives into the school site, where a
 member of staff will be based to welcome the children from the lay-by into the school
 grounds

If you require any further information / clarification regarding this, please drop me a reply email.

Can I also please ask for a meeting to discuss the community facility which is also detailed within this development? We discussed the concept of a floodlit multisport area for the community to use during evenings and weekends which would be located within our existing school field.
