### I find this local plan unsound for the following reasons

- Page 13 It states reliance of this site will be on neighbouring area which will be Stafford Borough Council and not South Staffs because of its location.
- Page 19 The site of this field is graded 3A. It has been growing potatoes for the last 50 years.
- Page 21 Encourage healthy communities through good health, education, open space, sports facilities, leisure and children play and youth development facilities will all fall under Stafford Borough Council.
- Page 22 Strategic objective 7 supporting tourism and agricultureboth not viable on this site as they are building on prime farmland.
- objective 8 Access to community services and facilities falling under Stafford Borough Council, not South Staffs.
- -objective 9 -again falls to Stafford Borough Council
- -objective 10- Cycling and footpath onto Wildwood Estate falls onto Stafford Borough
- Page 25 Protecting open countryside this site does not as it also violates the Cannock Chase wildlife as deer use the woodland of the site edges.
- Page 26 Policy DS3. 'Open countryside assist in delivering sustainable family enterprise –This plan destroys that concept
- Page 99 policy HC14. Health requirements will fall on an already overloaded Stafford Borough for this area
- Page 134 policy N31 Protecting, enhancing and expanding natural assets. This development will damage some of the Cannock Chase wildlife and therefore do the opposite

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
